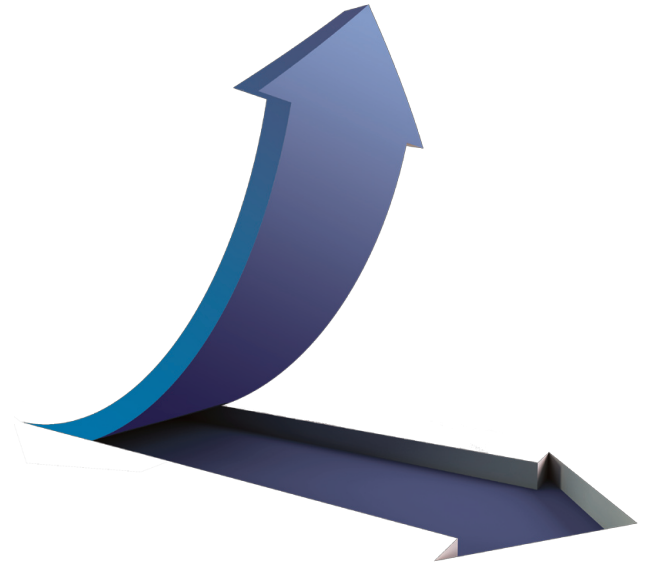
Time: from 6.30pm
